Below are just a few of the special daily encounters and stories we experience through our work.

4 friends from the UK visited the prison of Durres with Arber, our chaplain. One of the girls had become blind due to police actions. In her testimony she told that she had forgiven the police who did it. The Albanian inmates cried during her story, and thanked Arber for bringing such genuine people to them.

A pastor shared that he had unintentionally overheard a conversation through the door he was waiting in front of. The mother of the small family asked one of the children if she could please go to the store to get a package of macaroni, and if they could pay for it later.

The daughter said she felt ashamed because they had taken things on credit so often, after which the mother said they would have to go to bed without food.

The pastor had come to deliver a food package on our behalf...you can imagine the joy of this family.

Denis, our chaplain in the prison of Reç had a conversation with one of his counterparts, a pastor from a local church: "Actually, we go to the prison to encourage the inmates, but how often do we ourselves return encouraged!"

One of the inmates who has been regular visitor of their meetings had just thanked them. "For years, you have seen us when we were unseen, giving us hope when we had long given up on it ourselves. I will get released soon, can I join your church?"

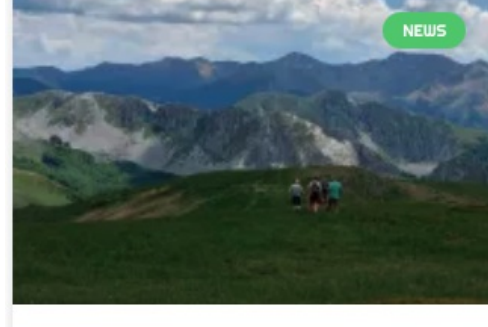

Amnesty-law finally passed the Albanian parliament.

Last month May, a long discussed and awaited amnesty operation began in Albania - more than 700 prisoners regained their freedom, and hundreds of others received reductions in their sentences of up to a year and a half.

In one prison, nearly all 20 regular participants of our church activities were released. So we need to start over in that prison, but it's wonderful to be able to meet the former inmates now outside of the prison walls.

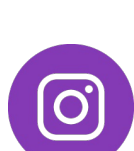
